Clinical implementations that occurred before and after retiring from the Georgia State Board of Pardons and Paroles/Department of Community Supervision include serving as the Counseling Director for a statewide recovery counseling program for people on parole, opening Georgia’s first five Day Reporting Centers and managing several statewide reentry initiatives as the Reentry Director, initiating the Transitional Housing for Offender (sic) Reentry Directory and the Reentry Partnership Housing program, facilitating an Enhanced Supervision Program training for correctional and reentry staff plus developing certification curricula for Recovery Residence Managers and for the REC-CAP, a recovery capital scale. George is a Charter Board Member of the National Alliance for Recovery Residences and a Recovery Consultant for SAMHSA’s Opioid Response Network.
